To Tank or Not to Tank

There really is no Question

An integral Part of any Fire Protection System is the availability of water to sufficiently run the system in the event of a Fire.

South Africa is unfortunate in that our municipal feeds are rarely of a high enough pressure paired with flow to efficiently supply our systems.

The more viable option would be Water Storage Tanks. Water Storage Tanks are available in either Square or Circular options with a multitude of configurations to choose from.

These tanks are sized in order to efficiently supply the system with the minimum capacity required according to the standardizing bodies.

Sprinkler systems are sized to supply the system with at least 90 minutes of Water, while Hydrant systems require a 60 minute supply.

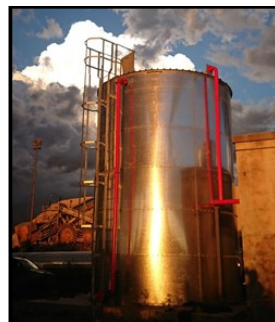
